The end of the school year always brings around farewells. As previously advised, we have a number of teachers leaving at the end of the year. Jess Scammell is heading down to Dunedin, Anya Berlad is travelling overseas, Sarah Taylor (one of our part time teachers) has picked up additional work at Titahi Bay School where she already works part time, and Rebekah Wright has decided not to return to us from maternity leave. As mentioned in our previous newsletter, Nicky Kenny is off to Papakowhai School and Kelly Gibbs is moving to Taranaki. Kim Holden, one of our Learning Assistants, has decided to hang up her LA boots and enjoy her retirement. We are incredibly grateful to all the staff who are leaving. Some have been with us for many years, while others only this year, but they have all contributed to our team and worked really hard for our tamariki and school community. We wish them all the very best for the next adventure in their lives.

We are also preparing to farewell 50 Year 8 students as they move to college, as well as a small number of children who are moving to schools outside the area. Our Year 8 group have made great contributions to our school in the time that they have been here, with many earning their school badge. We wish all departing students the best.

We are welcoming new staff to our team and have also made some great reappointments of staff who were with us on a fixed term basis. Jessica Shariff, John Manville and Marie Carkeek are all staying on as reappointments, which is great news. We have two new teachers joining our team as well - Amy Richards, who comes to us from Titahi Bay North School and Vicki Howarth who comes from Paraparaumu Beach School. Some of you who have long links with Discovery School may know Vicki as she used to teach here prior to 2016. Shaun Bishop and Suzette McVicar are both returning after taking leave in 2024. ## School Donations/Annual Charges/Credits

Thank you to those parents/caregivers who have paid their annual charges/donations for the year.

All school donations are voluntary, but they are a crucial source of funding for our school. Some schools can opt into a scheme where the Ministry of Education funds an additional \$150 per student to the school. Unfortunately, Discovery School is not eligible to access this as it is assumed we can access additional revenue through parent donations. Discovery School's expenditure budget (in particular our curriculum budget) is prepared on the basis of providing the best possible education outcomes for your child. The reality is we cannot do this without your help. Your donation is spent on staffing to keep our class sizes smaller, curriculum resources such as art paper, physical education gear, mathematics books, library books, computer consumables, lessons with outside providers such as Big Air Gym, subscriptions and musical instruments, all of which are used in the day to day education of your child.

Parent donations are an essential part of ensuring that we resource our school adequately. Without donations many of our wonderful school activities would not be able to proceed. While we understand not all whānau are in a position to pay a donation to the school, we are very grateful to those of you who can assist us through providing a donation.
